Course Description	- This course is designed for construction workers, foremen, job supervisors, and anyone involved in the construction industry. OSHA recommends Outreach Training Program courses as an orientation to occupational safety and health for workers covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1926. Workers must receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on the specific hazards of the job. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA construction safety and health 10-hour course completion card from the Department of Labor. Note: This is an instructor led course that will take place over a 2 day period.
Topics Covered	- Trainees are required to cover 7 hours of mandatory topics. Mandatory topics include: Introduction to OSHA; OSHA Focus Four Hazards; Personal Protective and Lifesaving Equipment; and Health Hazards in Construction. Trainees are also required to cover at least 2 hours of elective topics. At least 2 topics must be presented. These topics can be selected to tailor the client's needs. Elective topics include: Cranes, Derricks, Hoists, Elevators, & Conveyors; Excavations; Materials Handling, Storage, Use and Disposal; Scaffolds; Stairways and Ladders; and Tools (Hand and Power).
