Course Description	- This course covers thirty (30) hours of training, required by the Occupational Health and Safety Act (OSHA) that apply toward the 30-hour Construction Industry course completion card. The course is comprised of 25 sections, each either one or two hours in length, and covers topics pertaining to regulations covered by Standard 29 CFR 1926. The successful completion of this course will help meet the Construction Industry standards established by OSHA. Note: This is an instructor led course that will take place over a 4 day period.
Topics Covered	- Trainees are required to cover 15 hours of mandatory topics. Mandatory topics include: Introduction to OSHA; Managing Safety and Health; OSHA Focus Four Hazards; Personal Protective and Lifesaving Equipment; Health Hazards in Construction; and Stairways and Ladders. Trainees are also required to cover at least 12 hours of elective topics. At least 6 topics must be presented. These topics can be selected to tailor the client's needs. Elective topics include: Concrete and Masonry Construction; Confined Space Entry; Cranes, Derricks, Hoists, Elevators, & Conveyors; Ergonomics; Excavations; Fire Protection and Prevention; Materials Handling, Storage, Use and Disposal; Motor Vehicles, Mechanized Equipment and Marine Operations; Rollover Protective Structures and Overhead Protection; and Signs, Signals and Barricades; Powered Industrial Vehicles; Safety and Health Programs; Scaffolds; Steel Erection; Tools (Hand and Powered); and Welding and Cutting.
