Course Description	- This course is ideal for supervisors with safety and health responsibilities, and for employee safety and health awareness. Students will be introduced to OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as general industry safety and health principles covered in OSH Act Part 1910. Special emphasis will be placed on areas most hazardous using OSHA standards as a guide. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA general industry safety and health 10-hour course completion card from the Department of Labor. Note: This is an instructor led course that will take place over a 2 day period.
Topics Covered	- Trainees are required to cover 7 hours of mandatory topics. Mandatory topics include: Introduction to OSHA; Walking and Working Surfaces, including fall protection; Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, Fire Prevention Plans, and Fire Protection; Electrical; Personal Protective Equipment; and Hazard Communication. Trainees are also required to cover at least 2 hours of elective topics. At least 2 topics must be presented. These topics can be selected to tailor the client's needs. Elective topics include: Hazardous Materials; Materials Handling; Machine Guarding; Introduction to Industrial Hygiene; Bloodborne Pathogens; Ergonomics; Safety and Health Program; and Fall Protection.
